COVER LETTER: DEVELOPING BODY PARAGRAPHS

RESUME & COVER LETTER RESOURCE

When creating your cover letter body paragraphs, it is helpful to closely review the job description and reflect on your relevant experiences. Below are two strategies to get started.

ACTIVITY ONE: IDENTIFYING RELEVANT SKILLS AND EXPERIENCES

After you have identified the key skills required for the role, list them on the left side. On the right side, list relevant experiences you have that demonstrate the corresponding skill.

Reflecting on your experiences can offer insights into how you choose to proceed with your cover letter. Here are a few questions to consider below:

- 1. Did your experiences overlap in several skill areas? This is welcomed as often you will use multiple skills in a role!
- 2. Did you find yourself including more experiences in one area over another?
- 3. Did you have a moment to share the chart with a trusted person? Did they share further insights on your relevant experiences?
