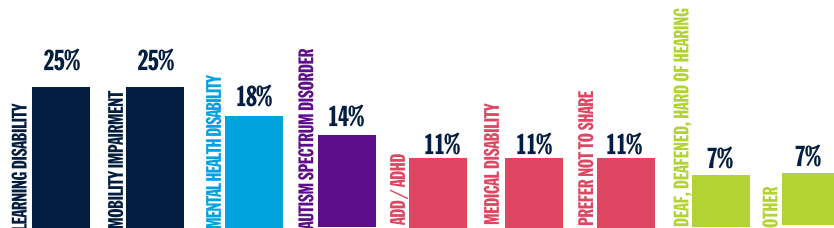

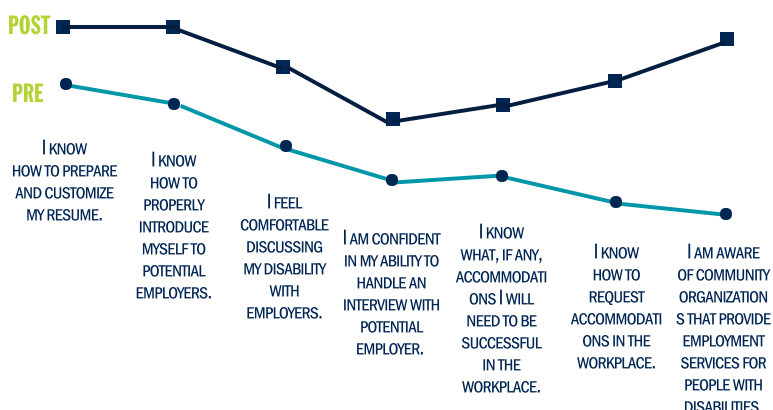
May 4th Job Fair (Day 2)

17 employers attended

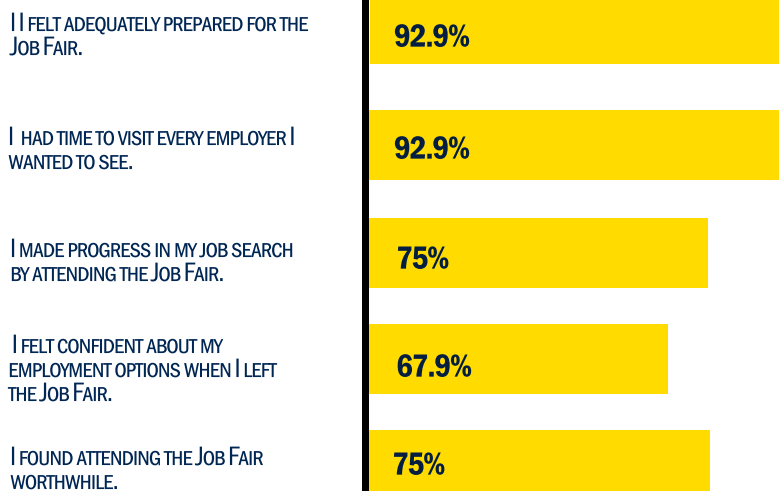


Student & Client PRE & POST Day 1 Event Reports
