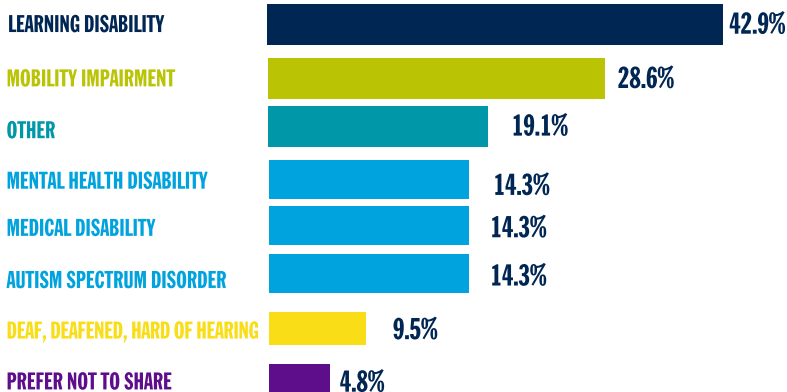
Student & Client Profile
