

TRANSITION TO WORK:

EMPLOYMENT SUCCESS FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Career Services, Accessible Learning Services, and Community Employment Services teamed up to bring career focused workshops and networking opportunities for students with disabilities. The event was delivered over two days: May 1, 2019 (employment workshops) and May 2, 2019 (panels and employment services).

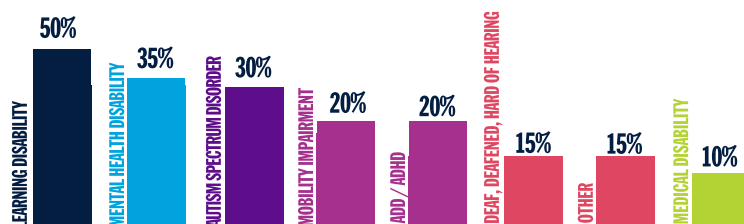

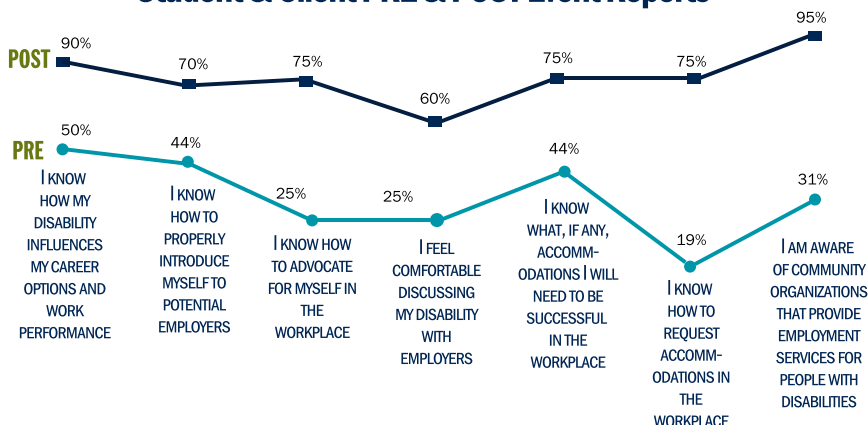
May 2nd Panels and Employment Services (Day 2)

15 community employment service organizations attended

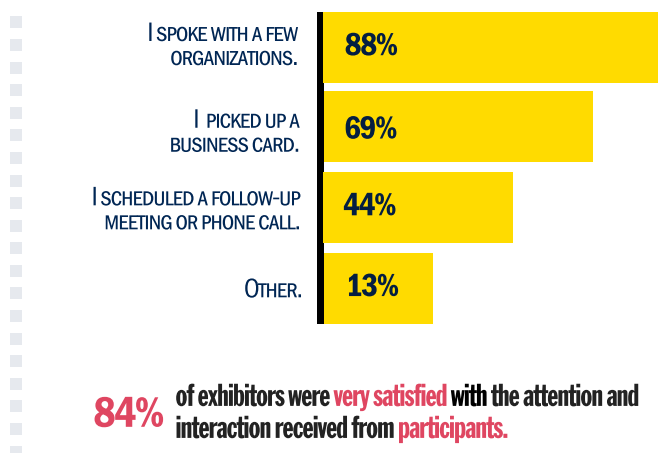


Student & Client PRE & POST Event Reports

Survey Respondent Feedback

90% of students & clients were **satisfied** with their overall event experience.

100% of students & clients **would recommend** the event to others.
